

Comments for your Friday, January 20, 2023 meeting.

I am writing in regards to your agenda item on identifying and prioritizing topics for 2023. I would like to see the addition of these issues that are related to Public Health and Community Impacts.

I live in an unincorporated area of El Dorado County where Commercial Cannabis Operation permits are being considered on agricultural parcels that are located in small community neighborhoods. Public Health issues include odor, dust and exposure to beta-Myrcene, a Proposition 65 contaminate related to cancer.

Community Impacts include residents safety and increased traffic on roads that were created and maintained by local residents. Existing road agreements will now need to incorporate commercial operations that will add additional traffic and added road maintenance.
