The CAC’s mandate is to advise DCC on the development of standards and regulations pursuant to Division 10 of the Business and Professions Code, including best practices and guidelines that protect public health and safety while ensuring a regulated environment for commercial cannabis activity that does not impose such barriers so as to perpetuate, rather than reduce and eliminate, the illicit market for cannabis.

The subcommittee is interested in receiving public input on the following questions to inform development of its scope and topics of discussion for 2023 meetings.

- What changes to regulations could be made to improve the quality of testing methods?
- What changes to regulations could be made to improve the accuracy of test results?
- How can further standardization between laboratories be achieved?
- What challenges are laboratories experiencing in moving to annual licensure?
- How can consumer understanding of and/or confidence in cannabis testing be strengthened?
- What guidance and information from DCC would be most helpful?

For each question above, the subcommittee chair will read the question and then open the floor for public comment.
